- 4. No Bulls in the Junior Beef Show. All beef females must be registered in the name of the junior exhibitor <u>only</u>. NO EXCEPTIONS! Every breeding female (over 6 months of age) must be registered with a breed association. This includes females shown in Section 6, Other Breeds.
- 5. There must be four different family breeders in any breed or they will be combined and judged with other breeds.
- 6. All market animals must weigh in Tuesday evening between 7:30 P.M. and 9:00 P.M. NO REWEIGHS.
- 7. Registration papers will be checked.
- 8. All Animals must be on the grounds by 8:00 A.M., August 14th, 2024.
